Tsebele, jarayeli hei nee yeɔ ebua me ni ame nine ashe nibii ni he hia ame Ɣe nɔ ni no bafeɔ nɔni ame shilhile damɔ nɔ kemiiha kpokpai babao. Nifeemɔi babao ni ke guɔyeli be tsakpa ye jara Ɣe mli Ɣe feɔ Ɣe faa ake tseŋemɔ helai anaa tsabaa ahe gbejianɔtoo Ɣe ji noko bibioo pe ni abaanye afee ye akpɔi ni awoɔ keku kɔyɔ mli helai ni gbɛ eshwaa ye kpokpai nee mli.

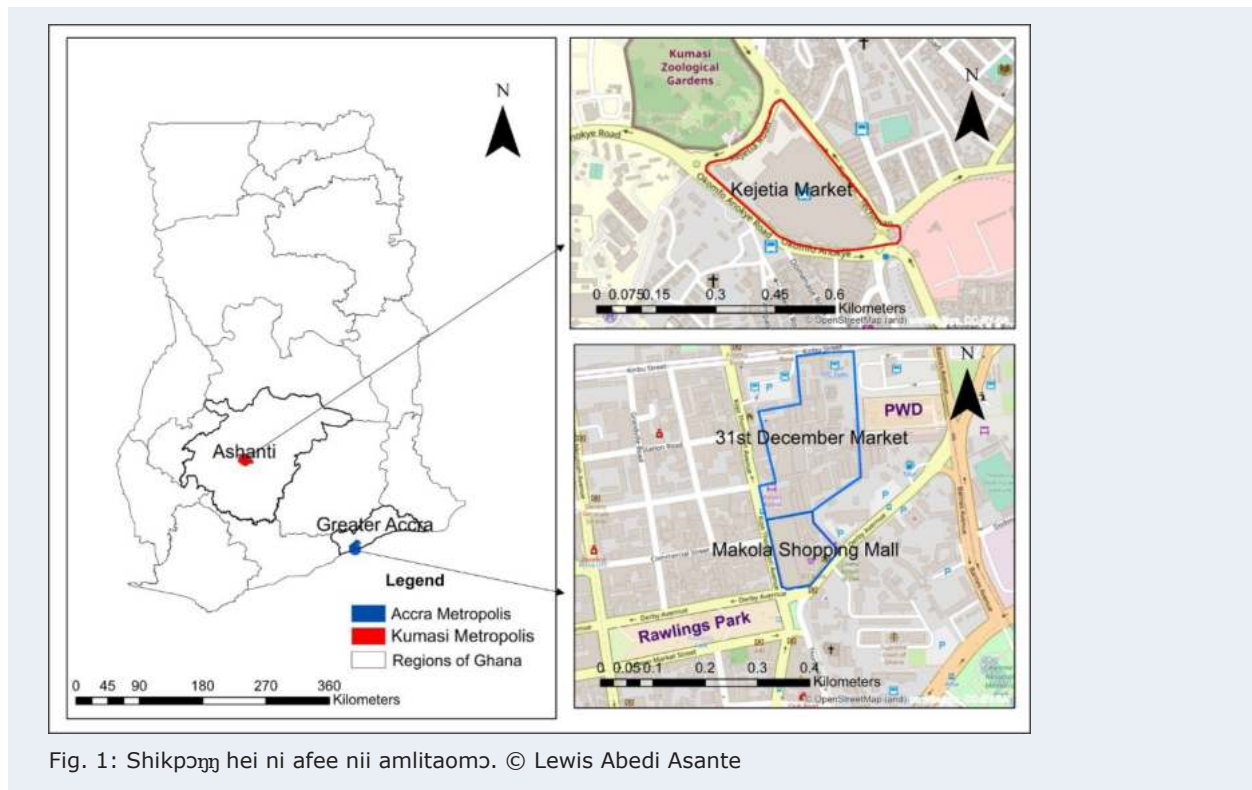


Fig. 1: Shikɔɔɲɲɛi hei ni afee nii amlɪtaomo. © Lewis Abedi Asante

I. Sɛɛfimo gbejianɔto kɛha kɔɔyɔ helai ni baa ni nine nyɛɛ ashɛ nɔ aloo faa

Yɛ 2020, maɲ kulalɔi ni yɔ Ghana kɛ COVID-19 he gbejɛmɔ gbejianɔto ba (CAP) koni no aye abua kpatu shika sɛɛfimo kɛha nitsumɔi bibii bibii, niɔ tumɔi bibii kɛ nitsumɔi pɛmpɛbii koni no aye abua kɔɔyɔ mli helai ni baa. Eyɛ mil akɛ shishitoo taomɔnii yɛ CAP – Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN), national ID card eko fɛɛ eko, passport picture kɛ nyɔɔgbele nihɔmɔ – jeeɛ noko ni yɛ kpɛɛ ni jwɛɲmɔ shɛɛ he, guɔyɛloɔi ni bɛ wojiaɲ ahie ayibɔ ni sa kadimɔ nyɛɛ ni amɛɲma koni amɛninɛ ashɛ shika nɔ ejaakɛ amɛ bɛ TIN. Guɔyɛloɔi ni gbe ɲmɛ amɛ ni Accra kɛ Kumasi ɲmala woji kɛ bibii shika sɛɛ fimɔ yɛ CAP shishi. Tsebele , mɛi babaoo nine shɛɛ hetoo yɛ woji ni amɛɲmala kɛ bibii shika yelikebuamɔ ni baaye ebua amɛ nitsumɔ shidaamɔ ni kɔɔyɔ helai kɛba. Kɛfata he lɛ, CAP atoko shika sɛɛ fimɔ pɔtɛ ko aloo gbejianɔ ni akɛ baafi kui ni saa amɛhe yɛ jarayeli hei nɛɛ, tamɔ ni terelɔi, trɔke tsilɔi kɛ shwapo walɔi, ni amɛhu shika he nagbaai ni kɔɔyɔ mli helai kɛba lɛ sa amɛ he lɛ. Kɛ abaahɛ ewo mli lɛ, maɲ kwraloɔi pɛ nyɛɲ amɛna shika kɛ fi mɛi ayɔsɛ akɛ ehe hia amɛ yɛ jarayeli hei nɛɛ.

II. Soɔi kɛha deɲ fomɔ ni-bii agbɛɛianɔto ni bɛ

De falefale – kɛtsɔ de fomɔ bɛ fɛɛ bɛ kɛ/aloo tsofai kɛhad Ōhand sanitizerɛ– ji gbɛ kome ni ato he gbejianɔ ni yɛɔ omanyɛ ni haa abaa COVID – 19 kɛ tsɛɲɛmɔ helai srotɔi ni gbɛɔ eshwaa lɛ shi. Bɛ mli ni de falefale feemɔ he bahia yɛ bɛ mli ni COVID-19 kɔɔyɔ helai je ehia kpoAs hand hygiene became critical in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, jarayeli he nɔkwɛloɔi ni yɔ Accra and Kumasi masi fee nibii ni bayɛ ebua de fomɔ ni ji Veronica buckets – ni nu yɛ mli – ni samina nu fata he kɛ de tso fa (hand sanitizers). Nɛkɛ falefale feemɔ he nibii ni akɛhaa lɛ je ankrɔaɲkroi, blema tsemɛi anɔkwɛloɔi (traditional authorities) kɛ nitsumɔheɔi kpanaa (corporate institution) adeɲ. Keji nibii nɛɛ ni akɛha ta, abɛ shika jɛshɛ ni akɛ baahe nɛkɛ falefale feemɔ he nibii ni akɛ tsuɔ nii yɛ jarayeli hei nɛɛ. Agbɛnɛ hu akɛ guɔyɛloɔi efeko gbejianotoo ko ni abaaha amɛ falefale feemɔ he nibii nɛɛ ni amɛkɛ tsuɔ nii yɛ jara lɛ mli. Shwapo awalɔi, nii terelɔi kɛ trɔke tsilɔi hu nuu he akɛ esani amɛkɛ nu awo Veronica buckets bei fɛɛ bei. Kɛfata he hu, de fomɔ gbejianotoo, yɛ bei pii amlɔi, ba shi yɛ otsi fioo komɛi asɛɛ ni nyiɛ ekɛnitsumɔ yɛ jarayeli hei ni yɔ Accra kɛ Kumasi.

gbɛjianɔtoɔ kɛ nitsumɔ hewalɛ yɛ Ghana jarayɛli hei, heni guɔyɛli he nifeemɔi yaa nɔ jogbaɲɲ yɛ he kɛ shramɔ kɛ mɛi pii yɛ hei ni ka shi lɛ. Enɛ feɔ hiamɔ kɛha akɔpo wolɔi lɛ farɲ akɛ amesaa amɛ jwɛɲ jɛɲ fɛɛ gbɛtsɔɔmɔ ni esani akɛ tsuni yɛ jarayɛli hei nɛɛ yɛ Ghana kɛ Africa kɛ mɔ shelii. I. Alɛ gbɛi ni atsoɔ nɔ akɛ yelikebuamɔ ni kɔɔ kɔɔyɔ hela lɛ he lɛ mli

Ake ɣaawoo ba ake jara nɔkwelɔi ke ame hewale nyemɔi awo deɣ fɔmɔ nibii afeɔmɔ (handwashing booth) ye jarayeli hei hee ni afee koni no awo deɣ fɔmɔ ke tsofa ke nitsumɔ ye deɣ hewale bei fɛe bei ye jarayelɔi ke meɔi ni ke meɔi tsuɔ nii ye mli le. Esa ake guɔyelɔi akuu hu awa ketso samina nu, OtissuesE ke de tsofai Ohand sanitizersE ni ame baaha koni no eye abua ni hei ni ato keha deɣ fɔmɔ le ni enye etsu nii ojogbaɣɣ. Ye be mli ni jeɣ fɛe gbɛɣianɔtoo ye tseɣemɔ helai akudumɔ le ni eye omanyɛ ni ake mli tsu nii ye hei babao, ehe miihia ni maɣ fe maɣ ahara gbe ni hi keha ame shihile. Ye nɔ najianɣ ni abaa ɣamɔ jarayeli hei nɛe aloo atsake meɔi abe ni ameke baaya nitsumɔ koni no aha ake he aka shra ye jarayeli hei nɛe ni meɔi babao tsuɔ nii ni wolo kaa he ni ame wala damɔ daagbi nihomɔ shika ni ame feɔ nɔ, esani jarayeli nɔkwelɔi ke ame hewale awo falefale feemɔ he nibii ni ame baato he gbɛɣiano ye jarayeli hei nɛe ketso hetsemɔ hieyaa ke kooɣɔ mli tsofa ni abaashi (fumigation) be fɛe be.
